The core of AFPNM is its Precinct Representatives. Only as a political party is connected to the people can it hope to accurately represent the needs and wishes of the people in government. AFPNM intends to have a Representative in every precinct in New Mexico to faithfully represent the interests of the people in that community.

The primary responsibility and role of the AFPNM Precinct Representative is to know the precinct he or she represents - since this is the precinct in which the Representative lives, it is simply a matter of reaching out to one's neighbors and knowing the issues that impact the community. Knowing what businesses are in the district, what political activists are working in the community and what government and bureaucratic positions exist over the precinct are some of the primary kinds of information needed.

With that knowledge, the Precinct Representative will work to make recommendations to the County Party about how the local community can best be served. The Representative will seek out the leaders and activists in the community and work to connect these individuals with the party, working to establish them as candidates for local, county, state and even federal offices.

The Precinct Representative does not just gather information though. He or she is empowered to vote in the County and State Central Committee Conventions and work together with the other Precinct Representatives to influence, from a grassroots base, what the party believes, stands for and practices.
